
THE FEAST OF ST PADRE PIO OF PIETRELCINA

This Friday 23 September, we celebrate the feast of our Parish Patron Saint, St Padre Pio of Pietrelcina (born Francesco Forgione).

St Padre Pio was a Franciscan Capuchin, friar and priest born on May 25, 1887, in Pietrelcina, Benevento, Italy and died on September 23 1968 at the age of 81 in San Giovanni Rotondo, Foggia Italy.

He was canonised a saint in 2002 by Pope John Paul II. St Padre Pio is recognised as the patron saint of civil defense works, volunteers, adolescence and the village of Pietrelcina in the Campania region near Naples in Italy.

Our Parish will be celebrating the Feast of St Padre Pio over four days commencing on Thursday, 22 September and concluding on Sunday, 25 September starting at 10am with a procession followed by the Feast Day Mass including veneration and blessing by St Padre Pio's relic.


