During this time of Lent, we are led to contemplate once again that Jesus was both a human person and at the same time divine.

The Lenten narratives always begin with Jesus in the desolate wilderness of the desert.

The Jordan Valley was a fairly fertile area. However, Jesus would not have had to travel a great distance to find himself in a desert

wilderness. The area was not only geographically rough, but it was also full of bandits and rebels - a dangerous place to be on your own.

The desert wilderness serves as a place of preparation for Jesus as he commences the last three years of his life and begins his active ministry which culminates with the utter desolation of His Passion.

So, while this experience was filled with pain, doubt and loneliness the desert is also a place of revelation and transformation for him.



Perhaps it is because we can personally relate with the humanity of Christ's own experience. In our personal struggles, doubts, missteps, losses and life-changing challenges we, in essence, share in His Passion.

The great promise of our Catholic faith that we celebrate at Easter is that after the desolation of the cross life will be transformed and prevail.

Dear Parents and Carers,

This week we celebrate **Catholic School Week.** It is a special week to celebrate and give thanks for the strength and distinctiveness of all Catholic Schools, especially our school Bethany. The theme for Catholic Schools Week this year is "Our teachers make the difference".

Catholic Schools Week (CSW) is an annual event which involves the communities of all 591 Catholic primary and secondary schools across NSW and the ACT. OUR NEW LOGO

You may have noticed that Catholic Schools Parramatta Diocese now have a new logo.



The central cross is made up of interlocking sections representing unity and community. This symbolises how we all come from different backgrounds but like the inside of the cross, we're joined together by our Catholic faith and values. The three circles that surround the cross are a representation of community, warmth and strength, and of the Holy Trinity. The lines flow into the base of the cross, showing that our schools are inclusive places for all, and acknowledging that we all experience a different journey to our Catholic schools.

NAPLAN

The official NAPLAN testing period for Years 3 & 5 is scheduled between 15th and 27th March. Teachers will be preparing students for NAPLAN by making them familiar with the type of questions and tools they will experience during the tests by using the demonstration site. Parents are welcome to access the public demonstration site as well to understand what the different NAPLAN assessments involve.

St Padre Pio Sacamental Program


Please keep the children who are preparing for the Sacrament of First Reconciliation in your prayers as well as their parents who are supporting them on their faith journey.

Premier's Reading Challenge for 2023

The Premier's Reading Challenge aims to encourage students to read for leisure and enjoyment, increase their reading and to experience a wide range of literature.

Kindergarten to Year 9 students in all NSW schools can participate in the PRC with certificates awarded at the end of each year to acknowledge students' achievements.

Last year at Bethany, 321 students completed the challenge with 26 achieving Gold and Platinum certificates for participating over a number of years.

Students in Years 3-6 have been reminded this week of how they can log their 20 books with the unique Username and Password they were issued with on a laminated bookmark last year. New students received their details this week.

Students in K-2 have received a note this week with information about the PRC and a bookmark with their logon details. K-2 students complete the PRC by listening to 30 books read aloud.

The Premier's Reading Challenge for 2023 closes on Friday 18th August.

Here are some steps to help you when logging the books you have read.

- 1. Go to the Premier's Reading Challenge website at: online.det.nsw.edu.au/prc
- 2. Click on "Logon" on the left side of the screen.
- 3. Enter the PRC username and password you have been given.
- 4. Click on "Student Reading Records" and type the titles of your books. Sometimes it auto-fills the information. Make sure it gives the correct author and title.
